APSCI 2023 GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Please read carefully the guidelines below for abstract submission.

1. Rules for abstract submission

- A. All abstracts must be submitted online through the APSCI 2023 website only at www.apsci2023.org. Your abstract submission will be acknowledged automatically by email. FAX OR EMAIL SUBMISSIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- B. Please follow the detailed instructions about the abstract submission below, and carefully make sure to complete all sections at the online abstract submission. If all sections are not completed, your abstract submission will NOT be accepted.
- C. Instructions on the preparation of presentations and information on the projection facilities will be included with the notification of acceptance.
- D. Authors are required to indicate their preference on the type of presentation between oral or poster presentation by checking the appropriate box on the submission page. The APSCI 2023 Scientific Committee, however, reserves the right to make the final decision on the type of presentation for all abstracts.
- E. Submission of an abstract indicates acceptance of and compliance with the abstract submission rules and the scientific validity of the presentation, and that all authors have read and approved the abstract and its contents
- F. All accepted abstracts will be published in the official abstract book and/or abstract USB and distributed to all delegates. Abstracts will be published exactly as submitted. Errors will not be amended by the organizing committee.
- G. Accepted abstracts are official documents of the meeting. The presenting author must register, attend the meeting and present the abstracts as scheduled. If the presenting author does not register and pay in full, the abstract will not be included in the symposium.
- H. The APSCI 2023 Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not observe the abstract submission rules mentioned above.
- I. Modifications may be made at any time until the abstract submission deadline of May 31, 2023.
- J. Acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be based on rankings given by a peer review of experts in the associated subspecialties. Notification of acceptance will be sent to the author by email. The reviewing process is confidential, and the decision is final and cannot be appealed.

2. Instructions for abstract preparation

- A. Language: Abstracts must be written and presented in English.
- B. **Title**: Use a concise title that indicates the content of the abstract. The complete title should not exceed **30** words. Refrain from using abbreviations in the title.
- C. **Authors**: Names and surnames of all co-authors must be provided. Do not include degrees or titles. Presenting author' name will be underlined, and corresponding author's name will be in bold.
- D. Institution: Each author must be listed by department, institution and country.
- E. Contents:
 - · Abstracts should not exceed 300 words.
 - Contents may be organized as the author sees fit, though they should include the purpose of the study, the methods used, a summary of the results and the conclusion reached. It is not satisfactory to simply state that "The result will be discussed."
 - · No tables, figures, graphs, and references are allowed.
 - · Animated images and animations are not permitted and will be non-functioning.
 - All abbreviations must be defined in first use. Only standard abbreviations may be used without definition. Data must be given in units widely used in literature (An international metric system is preferred).
 - Abstracts will be reproduced exactly as submitted and will not be edited in any way. The authors are responsible for all spelling, grammatical or scientific errors.
- F. Keywords: Three keywords must be entered.

3. Topics

For reviewing and scheduling purposes, abstracts will be divided into thematic areas. Please indicate on the submission page the appropriate topic classifications to which your abstract belongs to. The Scientific Committee will respect the authors' choice regarding their self-assignment of a topic, but it reserves the right to change the topic classifications in order to achieve a well-balanced scientific program.

No fee shall be paid to the author(s) by APSCI 2023 for the license granted herein. The author(s) will retain the copyright of his or her abstract as well.
- **E.** Authors who wish to withdraw their abstract should send a written request to the secretariat by e-mail at scientific@apsci2023.org. Abstract withdrawal is complete upon the confirmation of the secretariat.

5. Notification of Acceptance

Notification of Acceptance will be sent to authors **from June 26**, **2023** along with allocated sessions and requirements and instructions for presentations. If your abstract is accepted, please be sure to register and pay in full. If you do not register, your abstract will not be included in the abstract book/USB.
