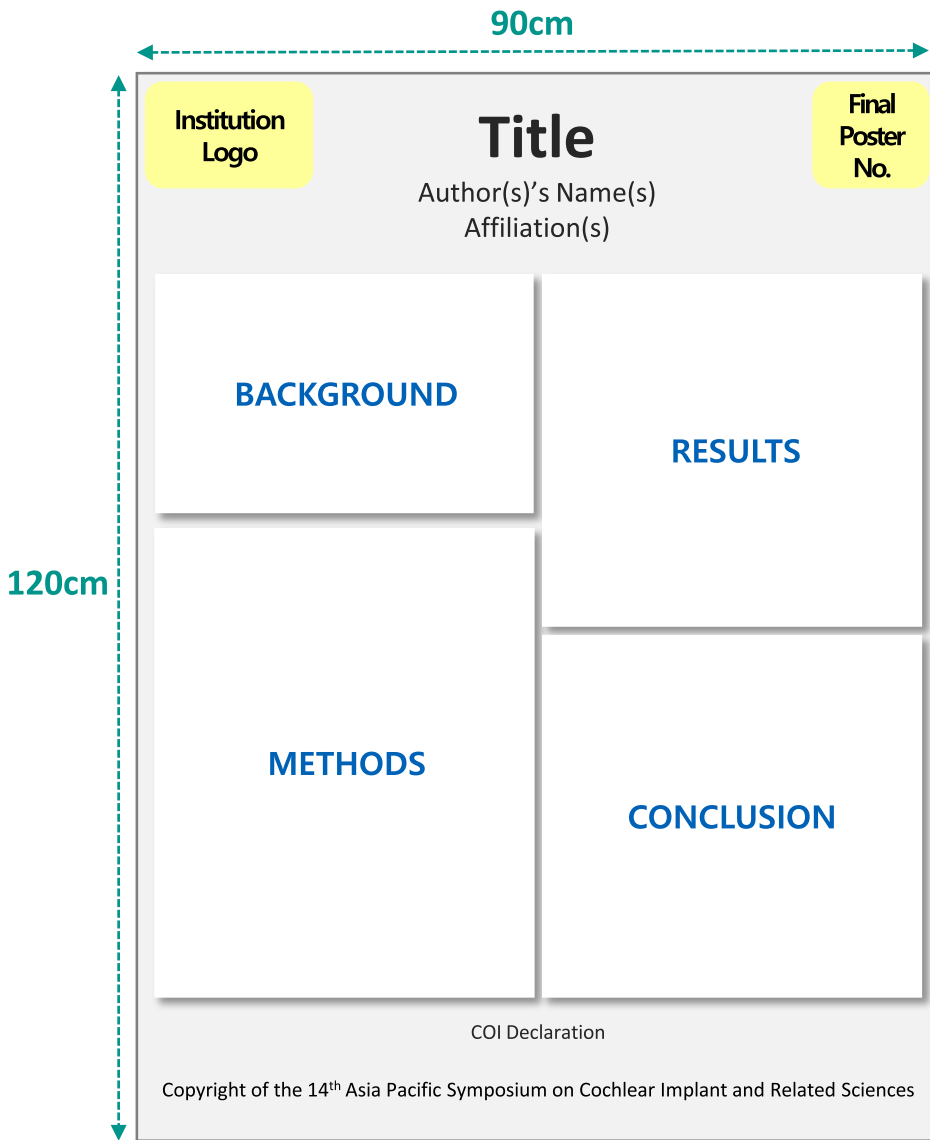


# Poster Presentation Guideline

<b>Size of Printed Poster</b>	90-cm by 120-cm (Width-by-height, Ratio of 3:4, Portrait, 1 page)
<b>Font</b>	Widely used font ( <b>Arial</b> or <b>Calibri</b> recommended.)
<b>How to Submit</b>	<p>It is the responsibility of the presenting author to prepare the printed poster, post it on the allocated poster board on site and remove it afterwards.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Poster hours and set-up &amp; removal schedule: To be announced later</li></ul>
<b>Disclosure of COI</b>	To avoid any commercial bias, all authors must disclose conflicts of interest in a statement at the bottom of the poster presentation.
<b>Registration</b>	<p><b>The presenting author must register and pay in full</b> for the symposium. Accepted abstracts whose presenting author does not register and pay in full, will be automatically withdrawn.</p>

TOP	1. Title	- The first letter of the first word in a title and the first letter of the first word after a colon must be capitalized. e.g.) Surgical issue: A case study
	2. Author's Name	- The LAST NAME must be capitalized. - Use superscripts to indicate the respective institutions of authors. e.g.) Ji-eun KIM <sup>1</sup> , Ji Hoon PARK <sup>2</sup>
	3. Affiliation	<sup>1</sup> Department of Otorhinolaryngology, Seoul National University Hospital, Korea <sup>2</sup> Speech & Hearing Center, Korea Medical Institute, Korea
